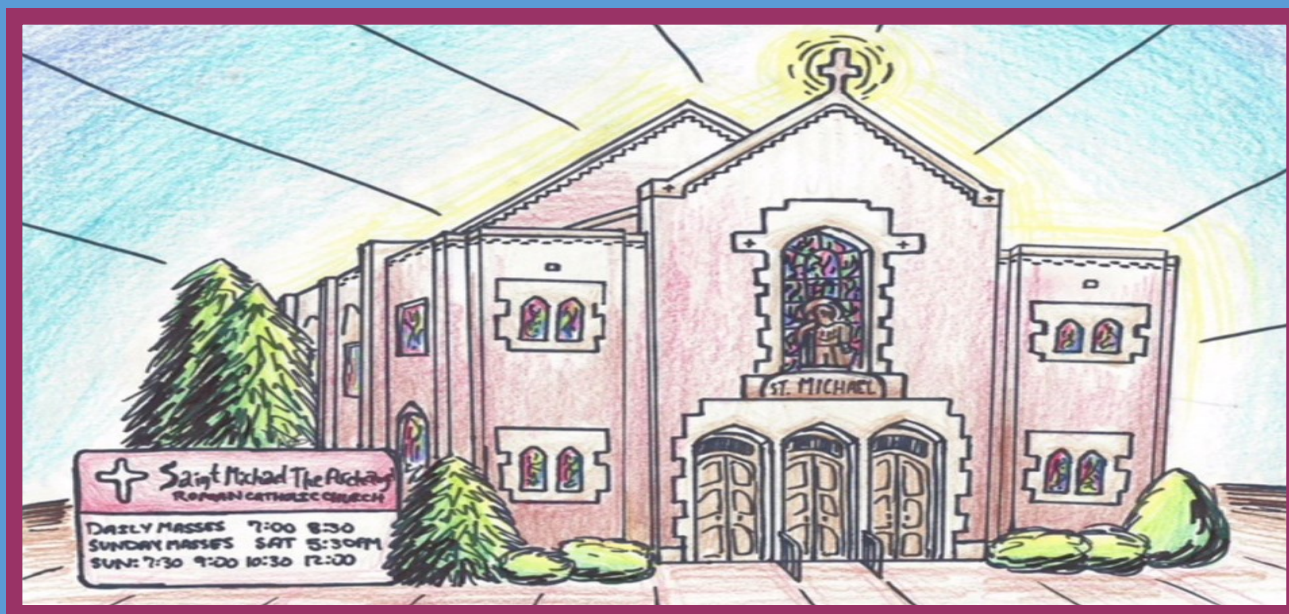

Registration for our 2019-2020 Confirmation Class has begun and registration forms have been mailed out to all 8th grade student parents.



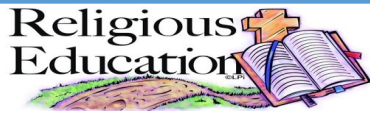

HOW TO REPORT ABUSE

The Archdiocese of Newark takes very seriously any and all credible complaints of sexual abuse of minors by members of the clergy, religious, lay staff and volunteers of the Archdiocese. We encourage anyone with knowledge of an act of sexual abuse of a minor to inform the Archdiocese immediately so that we can take appropriate action to protect others and provide support to victims of sexual abuse.

Who can I contact to report an allegation of sexual abuse or misconduct? If you suspect a child is in imminent danger from abuse, please call 911 immediately. To report known or suspected child abuse: Contact the Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCPP) 24-Hour Child Abuse Hotline: 1-877-652-2873 and, contact your County Prosecutor: Bergen County 201-646-2300 Essex County 973-621-4700 Hudson County 201-795-6400 Union County 908-527-4500. Allegations of sexual misconduct may also be reported by calling the Archdiocesan Office of Child and Youth Protection at (201) 407-3256.

We look forward to seeing you all at our first meeting for our 2019-2020 year on Monday, September 16th.

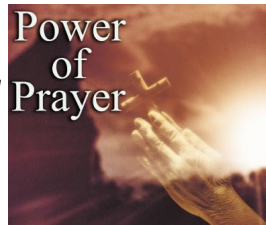
