# Message From Our Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

#### **October Marian Devotion**

The Sistine Chapel houses one of the most iconic paintings the world has ever known—"The Last Judgment" by Michelangelo. In this painting, Michelangelo positions our Lady at the right hand of her Son, Jesus. Then, just beneath her, he painted a huge Rosary hanging down over the rampant of Heaven, on which hung two souls climbing their way into heaven.

In Her apparition to Fr. Cobbi, on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 1983, Our Lady said that prayer is a potent force that starts a chain reaction in good that is far more powerful than any atomic reaction. She then said: "The prayer of my predilection is the Holy Rosary. In her last apparition at Fatima, on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 1917, Our Lady appeared as the "Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, with the request: "Pray the Rosary Daily"

Here are some of the promises our Blessed Mother made about praying the rosary as revealed to St. Dominic and Blessed Alan de la Roche:

- \* Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary shall receive powerful graces. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell; it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies. It will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of people from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things.
- \* Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have during their life and at their death the light of God and the plentitude of His graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the Saints in Paradise.
- \* I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.
- \* You shall obtain all you ask of me by the recitation of the Rosary.
- \* All who recite the Rosary are my children, and brothers and sisters of my only Son, Jesus Christ.

October, as we know, is the month of the Holy Rosary. To honor our Blessed Mother, we shall recite the Rosary every evening at 7:00 pm via our Church's streaming medium, GoToMeeting. Please go to our web page <a href="www.stmichaelunion.org">www.stmichaelunion.org</a> and click on the GoToMeeting link to join us. Any family that would like to lead the rosary on any given night should please contact the parish office.

On October 7<sup>th</sup>, we will join the Archdiocese in a 12- hour marathon Rosary beginning from 8:00 am through 8:00 pm. The Rosary will be recited at the beginning of every hour. This will take place in the Church. Please check your schedule and make sure to participate with your family in this spiritual exercise. There will be an exposition of the Blessed Eucharist throughout the duration of this holy observance and we will close it with a Benediction. The exposed Blessed Sacrament is never to be left alone, unattended.

# **UPDATE 2020/2021 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM**:

Our textbooks have arrived. If you missed our pickup dates last week, you may come to the Religious Education Office, 1211 Orange Avenue on Monday, October 5 through Thursday, October 6 between the hours of 9:30AM and 2:30PM. No appointment is necessary.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Only a Parent or Legal Guardian may pick up the child's book as they will be asked to sign a Permission Form that allows their child to participate in St. Michael's Faith Formation Program Sessions through the use of our digital platform. We cannot assign your child to a Google Classroom until we have these documents in hand. Please also remember to observe social distancing and wear a mask at all times when on the premises.

Virtual classes start Sunday, October 4. Grades 1-5 will receive an invitation to join Google Classroom for Religious Education for their respective grade and a lesson will be posted on that date. Grades 6-8 can expect the same on Tuesday evening, October 6.

We are still in need of a few good catechists – men and women who are willing to share their faith with the children, particularly Grade 8 and Sacrament Prep 1 (very small group for children who have not had any religious education to date). No experience is necessary. We will provide training and assistance. You simply need a desire to assist our young people in developing a relationship with God and some basic computer skills due to the nature of our program this year. 
