Dear Parishioners,

UPDATE 2020/2021 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM & REMINDER TO REGISTER:

We have received guidance from the Archdiocese Office that Religious Education classes in the fall shall remain virtual, that is digital or remote. In accordance with this guidance and to ensure the safety of our students, families and volunteers, we are in the process of developing a platform for remote learning. A homebased option will continue to be available for families who prefer to teach 1:1 with their child. We are looking to begin the program during the first week of October.

Registration forms have been mailed previously or you can access the form from the St. Michael's website under the tab "Faith Formation/Religious Education." **If you have not done so already, please register your child as soon as possible** so that we can order the appropriate number of books and supplies for the year. Late fees will not be charged provided we receive your registration prior to September 15. Please do not let financial difficulties keep you from registering your child. We are still in need of a few good catechists – men and women who are willing to share their faith with the children. No catechetical experience is necessary. We will provide training and assistance. You simply need a desire to assist our young people in developing a relationship with God and some basic computer skills due to the nature of our program this year.
